CMS GENERAL INFORMATION

- Some questions/ misconceptions:
 - New students who joined CMS in July 2025 must follow the new worksheets and changes in the calendar.
 - Chem 355 is the new course number for the Chem lab course. CMS students are not eligible to take Chem 315 (that's the old course number)
 - Some courses have extra pre-requisites and that is a departmental decision. CMS or science advising cannot exempt you from that.
 - Biol 180 is the new course code for Biol 140. So completing either one is sufficient.
 - Combined major in two disciplines different from CMS which is 3 disciplines.
